Charlotte Mecklenburg Library touched 5,000 students through Storyvine. Storyvine is the result of a partnership between Charlotte Mecklenburg Library, Charlotte Mecklenburg Schools (CMS) and Richland County Public Library. Storyvine took place in May when 37 Storytellers descended upon CMS to help enrich the lives of second graders in Title One schools. About 5,000 students were the enthusiastic recipients.
