Charlotte Mecklenburg Library earned the highest score on the Center's Network Achievement Report, a quality assessment tool used to evaluate each partner's commitment to providing free access to and

training on Foundation Center grantseeking tools and resources. Over 80 percent of 450 Funding Information Network partners completed the Network Achievement Report.

The Network, comprised of more than 450 partners located in every U.S. state and 12 countries is located in libraries, community foundations, and other nonprofit resource centers.

Funding Information Network partners offer free access to Foundation Center databases, publications, and a variety of supplementary materials and services useful to the nonprofit sector.
